On behalf of the Organizing and Scientific Committees, we are pleased to invite you for the second conference devoted to the issue of the impact of climate change on the natural resources of the broadly understood border areas.

Past and present global climate change and their impact on the natural environment according to socio-economic conditions of the border area, including the borders of states, provinces, cities, ecologically protected areas as well as water and land ecosystems, are important and current issues not only from the point of view of modern human being but also from the point of view of future generations and their possibilities of existence in conditions of sustainable development.

The aim of our activity is to initiate cyclic, interdisciplinary, international meeting organized alternately in Poland and in Ukraine dedicated to the necessity of protection of natural resources in the context of global climate change.

The NARBAC conference is aimed at an interdisciplinary group of scientists, employees of protected areas, representatives of local governments, economic sector and residents. Discussion in such a wide range of attendants will allow for an assessment of the dynamics of changes of border ecosystems under conditions of changes concerning the entire planet as we as for exchange of local experiences.

The following is a selection of topics for which the Scientific and Programme Committee of NARBAC 2018 is particularly seeking contributions:

- changes in quaternary sediments based on paleoenvironmental data;
- changes in water, soil, biological and mineral resources;
- past record and analysis of current human economic activity in the natural environment;
- methods of past changes testing and forecasting;
- emission of pollutants into selected environmental compartments;
- climate and water policy reduction and adaptation measures;
- changes in agricultural production conditions;
- trends in biodiversity change in different border ecosystems;
- development of tourism (geotourism) and recreation;
- the impact of global changes on the sector economy: forestry, energy, transport, agriculture, spatial management and urban areas;
- sustainable regional and local development taking into account climate change;
- the functioning of protected areas under conditions of climatic instability.
